

GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES

- ENTRY FEES: \$90 (TD) / \$125 (TDX) payable in US dollars. Entry fee includes a \$.50 AKC recording fee & \$3.00 event fee. Make checks & money orders payable to BSTDCM.
- 2. CLOSING DATE: Entries will be accepted until 5:00 pm, Thursday May 30, 2024 after which time entries will not be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted.
- 3. For other delivery options call test secretary for instructions. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. There will be a \$25 collection fee for any returned checks.
- 4. DRAWING FOR ENTRIES: This test is limited to 3 TD/3 TDX dogs. A random drawing will take place 9:00 am Friday, May 31, 2024 at the Mansfield Library, 32 Campus Drive, Missoula, MT. Contact test secretary for directions to draw site. Preference shall be given to dogs that have not previously earned the Tracking Dog or Tracking Dog Excellent title. Two tracks will be set aside for BSTDCM test workers who submit a BSTDCM issued worker certification with their entry form. Entrants/Alternates will be notified by phone or email as soon as possible.
- 5. DRAW FOR RUNNING ORDER: 7:00 am (TD); TDX draw will be at the conclusion of the TD test, not before 8:45 am. Handlers must be at the Tracking Test area before 7:00 AM on Sunday, June 9, 2024, at which time there will be a drawing for track order. Entrants not present at the time of drawing for tracks may be marked absent and an alternate allowed to run in their place.
- **6. START OF JUDGING**: Judging will start as soon as the first track has aged the required time. Test hours: 6:30-4:00 pm
- 7. **REFUND POLICY**: The entry fee will be refunded if either 1) entrant notifies test secretary prior to the draw 2) the entrant notifies the secretary prior to the test and an alternate runs the track, or 3) the dog is an alternate who does not run a track.
- BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE. The Test Secretary and judges must be notified that a bitch is in season prior to the drawing for tracks. The last track(s) to be laid shall be reserved for bitch(es) in season. Bitches in season shall be allowed on the tracking field only immediately prior to their running.
- 9. EXTREME WEATHER CONDITIONS: The AKC believes the wellbeing of dogs and participants are of paramount importance. In the case of adverse weather conditions, the test could be canceled and rescheduled.
- AKC RULES: All entrants are responsible for complying with the AKC rules regarding Tracking Tests and other AKC rules referred to in the Tracking Test Rule book.
